Garden Clubs Scholarship Fund

The Garden Club Scholarship Fund assists Canadian students, typically British Columbia residents, in furthering their education in horticulture in a recognized accredited college or university through the granting of scholarships and bursaries.

The Fund*

The Fund consists of donations from garden clubs, bequests and other sources, and these donations become and remain part of the Fund. Only earned income from the Fund is dispersed annually in the form of scholarships and bursaries. Administrative expenses are paid by the Council.

The Committee

The Committee consists of three trustees, each elected for a three year term, who are responsible for the proper administration of the Fund.

Their responsibilities include:

- ◇ Ensuring the Funds are invested based on the requirements of the constitution and the Trustees Act
- ◇ Distributing scholarships and bursaries from interest earned
- ◇ Ensuring capital remains intact
- ◇ Presenting a report to membership at the AGM

Trustees' role includes: promoting the Fund, increasing Fund capital, increasing awards when possible and encouraging donations.
